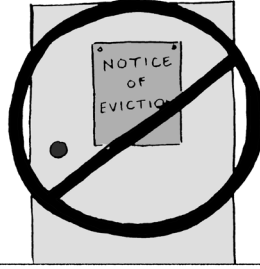


KNOW YOUR RIGHTS:

Housing During Quarantine in Cleveland, Ohio

Even if your water and power were shut off before all of this happened...

...and they'll turn them back on!








Cleveland isn't hearing new eviction cases at the moment. Your landlord can still file a case, but they won't get a court date til June 15. Even if you have a pending case, it won't be heard before May 18 at the earliest.

Also, if your landlord is trying to evict you for not paying rent, but got federal government assistance for their mortgage, you can't be evicted til after July 25th!


There isn't an eviction ban at the state level yet, but even if you live outside of Cleveland, you should call your local municipal housing court and ask whether they've put any measures in place to protect renters.
